SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Screen the giraffe on to the mug with Black goo by lining the design up with the handle.
2. Paint the handle, the inside of the mug, and the giraffe's body (around the spots) with 3 coats of Yellow.
3. Paint the space under the feet with 2 coats of Lime, then paint the background (around the grass and giraffe) with 3 coats of Blue.
4. Fill in the spots and hooves with 1 heavy coat of Brown along with a few lines in the legs. Paint in the ears with 1 coat of Pink.
5. Paint the leaves in the mouth, then the blades of grass up onto the sky with the Lime and add in details with the Green.
