SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Place your silkscreen in the center of the plate. Starting at the top, screen on the star and lines using Yellow Goo.
2. Then use Lime Green Goo to screen on the top section of the tree, immediately start to blend Green Goo to the bottom part of that section before working down the tree. Follow that by immediately using Dark Green Goo to overlap where you left off and work down to the bottom of the tree.
3. Finally, you'll use Brown Goo to screen on the trunk.
4. Paint on 2 coats of Speckled White to the rim of the platter.
5. Use a sponge dotter to create the dots on the border. Then take a detail brush to create two messy lines to help frame the border.
