BISQUE:

Gare 1021 Angled Rim Dinner Plate

PYOP STUDIO STUFF SUPPLIES:

- Farmhouse Truck Silkscreen - Truck Load 3 Silkscreen
- Merry Christmas 7 Ways Silkscreen
- Buffalo Plaid Silkscreen

SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Paint the inside of the plate with two coats of Cream using a fan brush. While the second coat of Cream is still wet, use your fan brush to lightly sweep on some Tan paint to give the background a rustic wood look.
2. Paint the rim of the plate with 3 coats of Red and allow to dry.
3. Screen on the truck and the tree in the middle of the plate with Black goo, then screen on Merry Christmas with Red goo.
4. Working sections at a time, use Black goo to screen the plaid to the rim of the plate. Rinsing off periodically can help you line up the pattern.
5. Fill in the truck and tree with 1-2 heavy coats of your desired colors, then use a detail brush to add in some Dark Green details to the tree. Then use Black to make a small broken border inside the rim of the plate.
