SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

- I. Paint 3 coats of Blue on the plate using a fan brush and allow to dry.
- 2. Then use Black goo to piece together your scene. We started with the scarecrow and then added in the other elements. To make the designs look like they are "behind" another element, wash out your screen so that you can see through it, and use your finger to screen on the design around the item you previously put on the plate.
- 3. Water down the colors for the rest of the design by squeezing water into the paint and mixing it in. We used 50% water and 50% paint.
- 3. Use your desired colors to fill in one heavy coat of watered down paint, don't worry about going around the black lines, they'll come back through in firing.
