SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

- I. Paint two heavy coats of Cream all over the top of the piece. While the second coat is still wet, use your fan brush to add some watered down Light Brown to give the distressed wood look.
- 2. After the background dries, use Black goo to screen on the truck and the pumpkins in the bed of the truck. We used the larger pumpkins to make the pumpkins on the corners, then we added the sign.
- 3. Fill in the truck with your desired colors by doing 1-2 heavy coats.
- 3. Fill in the pumpkins with your desired shades of Orange and Yellow, using the Dark Green for the tendrils. Just one heavy coat on these is enough.
- 4. For the sign and the pumpkin stems, one watered down coat of Brown is plenty! Use a writer bottle to write on your sign!
