### SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Screen on the Santa gnome using Black goo leaving about 1.5" on the bottom for the word.
2. Paint in 2 heavy coats of Lime to the background.
3. Fill in the mustache with 1 heavy coat of Light Grey, and then add in a few lines of White to add detail.
4. Paint in the rest of the details using 1 heavy coat of your desired colors.
5. Use Black goo to screen on the word "Merry" under Santa.
6. Paint 3 coats of red to the edges and back of the plate.
