SKELETON JACK O' LANTERN

BISQUE

Gare 5318 Tall Pumpkin

PYOP STUDIO STUFF SUPPLIES:

Jack O' Lantern Faces 2 Silkscreen

COLORS USED:

White:

Gare 2300 Polar Bear
Mayco SC16 Cotton Tail
Duncan CN241 White

Black:

Gare 2314 Black Lab
Mayco 2315 Tuxedo
Duncan CN253 Black

Grey:

Gare 2395 Tin Man
Mayco SC60 Silver Lining
Duncan CN201 Light Grey

SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Paint the pumpkin with two coats of White. While the second coat of White is still damp, add highlights of Grey in the creases, as well as up on the top of the pumpkin sweeping down onto the front.
2. Allow to dry. Next paint the stem with 3 coats of Black, and then screen on the face using Black goo.
3. Use a small brush with Grey to add some shadows around the eyes, nose, and mouth.
