SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Grab a paper towel and crumple it up, you'll use it on this step. Paint the outside of the mug with 2 coats of Golden and allow to dry. Working in sections, use a fan brush to apply a watered down coat of Light Brown and immediately blot with crumpled paper towel to create the mottled effect. Paint two coats of the watered down Light Brown on the inside.
2. On one side of the mug, screen on the truck, the pumpkins in the bed of the truck, and the quote using Brown goo. On the other side of the mug screen on two pumpkins. To make them overlap, screen on one, then overlap the screen for the next one, just be sure to only apply the part of the second pumpkin that doesn't overlap the lines from the first one.
3. Using one heavy coat fill in the truck with Teal for the body, Grey for the trim, and Black on the tires.
4. To fill in all of the pumpkins, add water to the paint and fill in with one heavy coat using the desired colors.
