### SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Before you screen on this piece, we found it helpful to run the screen under warm water and dry it off with paper towels. This makes the screen more flexible to help it fit easily into the bottom of the bowl. Screen on the cornucopia only using Brown goo. We will add the word later.
2. To fill in the cornucopia, water down your colors by squeezing water into paint in your pallet. Fill in your design with your desired water colors doing just one heavy coat and not worrying about the lines, they'll come through.
3. Paint around the cornucopia with 3 coats of Speckled Cream
4. Paint three coats of Light Green to the background and top rim.
5. When everything is dry, use the Brown goo to screen "Thankful" inside the bowl. Then use Brown, Maroon, Green, and Light Brown Goo to screen on different fall words to the outside of the bowl.
