Yellow:

Gare 2301 Smiley Face
Mayco SC6 Sunkissed
Duncan CNO12 Bright Straw

Dark Yellow:

Gare 2315 What A Yolk
Mayco SC24 Dandelion
Duncan CNO32 Bright Butternut

Orange:

Gare 2390 Orange Crush
Mayco SC75 Orange A Peel
Duncan CN504 Neon Orange

Red:

Gare 2392 Rockin' Red
Mayco SC74 Hot Tamale
Duncan CNO74 Really Red

BISQUE:

Gare 1023 Swoop Sushi Salad Plate

PYOP STUDIO STUFF SUPPLIES:

1/8" Studio Stripes

SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Start by using a marker to draw a line down the center of the plate to help space the stripes.
2. Starting on the right of the line, put a piece of tape down smoothing it as you go to about the middle of the plate. After the middle, you'll want to steer the tape toward the right as you press down. Repeat this step to the left of the line to create the center stripe.
3. Next, apply two more pieces of tape on each side of the center lines following the same "bent line" design, so that there are a total of 6 lines of tape which will represent 5 areas to apply color.
4. Use the desired colors to paint in 3 coats of a color between each of the tape lines
