SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Use Black goo to screen on the penguin.
2. Paint one coat of Speckled White to the outside of the mug, working around the penguin.
3. The Blues are listed in order from darkest to lightest. Start at the top of the penguin with Navy, and then work your way down using lighter colors as you go, ending with Lightest Blue. One heavy coat is all you need. We left the belly unpainted.
4. Paint the inside of the mug with 3 coats of Speckled Light Blue, and 3 coats of Speckled Dark Blue for the handle.
