Lime Green: Gare 2373 Key Lime Pie Mayco SC78 Lime Light Duncan SC171 Light Kelp

Speckled White: Gare 2420 Paparazzi Mayco SP216 Speckled Cotton Tail Duncan CN522 Really White Sprinkles

Green : Gare 2341 Kermit Mayco SC26 Green Thumb Duncan CN182 Bright Kiwi

Maroon Gare 2379 Simply Cinnamon Mayco SC81 Cinnamon Stix Duncan CN508 Chutney Spice

SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

I. Screen the bow at the top of the platter, "mistletoes" at the bottom, and the circles toward the sides leaving room for feet. Fire on design to create coloring book pottery.

- 2. Use Green paint to apply the feet to the plate.
- 3. Use Speckled White to apply one coat of paint to the background of the plate, painting around the design elements.
- 4. Use a sponge dotter to apply Red to some of the circles and Lime Green to the rest of the circles.
- 5. Apply one generous coat of Red to the background of the bow, one generous coat of Lime Green to the dots on the bow, and one generous coat of maroon to the loop of the bow.
- 6. Use a detail brush to make the Red strings from the bow to the feet, then add in details on the letters alternating Red and Lime Green.
