SILKSCREENS AND COLORS:

POTTERY PIECE:

Gare 5240 Large Standing Cross

PYOP STUDIO STUFF SUPPLIES:

Spirograph Painting Lace

SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Paint 2 coats of Black to the front of the cross with a fan brush.
2. Quickly paint a HEAVY coat of black with the fan brush, then immediately lay your lace onto the wet paint and press down.
3. Take a stiff square brush and firmly paint one more thin coat of black on top of the lace to seal it down.
4. Dab in 2 heavy coats of desired colors to the spaces in the design, don't worry about the lines they'll come through when you remove the lace.
5. When the paint starts to lose its shine, peel off lace!
