SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Paint 2 coats of White to the top of the plate and allow to dry before screening on sushi pieces to the background using Grey goo.
2. Screen on the soy sauce bottle, and 3 sushi pieces with Black goo, then color in with one heavy coat of desired colors.
3. Paint the rim and back of the plate with 3 coats of Green.
