### SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

1. Water down the Lime paint with 50% water to 50% paint. Use a fan brush to paint on 2 swishy coats.
2. Use Black Goo to screen on the taco (leaving the words off as well as the center part of the bottom line).
3. Use the stegosaurus from the "Dinosaurs" silkscreen and apply just the tail, the head, the feet, and the belly.
4. Paint in the rest of the details of your tacosaurus with 1 heavy coat of your desired colors.
5. Use a 3/4" sponge dotter to apply Green spots to the background of the plate. Allow to dry.
6. Screen on the word "Tacosaurus".
