Under the Microscope Painting Lace

SUPER SIMPLE STEPS:

- 1. Paint on 2 coats of Navy to the outside of the mug.
- 2. Do a very heavy very fast third coat of Navy on the outside of the mug again, then immediately put the lace on the piece pressing all over. Take at stiff flat brush and brush one more thin coat of Navy on top of the lace to seal it down. Don't skip that step it make all the difference!
- 3. Using 2 heavy coats, fill in the design using Blue, Lime, and Green working all over the top of the lace and allow to dry.
- 4. When the paint starts to lose shine, go ahead and peel off the lace.
- 5. Paint the inside and lip of the mug with 3 coats of Green and then paint 3 coats of Navy on the handle.
