## BLUE DELFT TURKEY PLATTER

### POTTERY AND TOOLS:

#### BISQUE:

Chesapeake DB21701 Coupe Charger 13"

#### PYOP STUDIO STUFF SUPPLIES:

Vintage Turkey Platter BAS Silkscreen

### COLORS USED:

#### White:

Mayco SC67 Cotton Tail  
Gare 2300 Polar Bear  
CMM 67 Snowflake

#### Pale Blue:

Mayco SC45 My Blue Heaven  
Gare 2387 Pool Party  
CMM 62 Just Blue

#### Medium Blue:

Mayco SC76 Cara-bein Blue  
Gare 2396 Achors Away  
CMM 11 Blue Lagoon

#### Dark Blue:

Mayco SC12 Moody Blue  
Gare 2306 Blue By U  
CMM 43 Saffire

### SUPER SIMPLE STEPS: You need Goo in Dark Blue

1. Water down White and Pale Blue by mixing 50/50 paint and water.
2. Apply two coats of the watered-down colors to the top of the plate, alternating colors as you reload your brush. Allow the colors to overlap and mix. Allow the plate to dry for a few minutes.
3. Use a screen squeegee to apply the turkey in the center of the screen with Dark Blue goo. You can use masking tape to tape off any elements on the screen that are too close to the turkey to make it easier. Rinse and dry the screen.
4. Apply leaves going around the rim of the plate, rinsing the screen as needed.
5. Water down some Medium Blue paint by mixing 50/50 paint and water.
6. Use a toothbrush and splatter the entire top of the platter.
7. Glaze, fire, and admire! (if doing a class, make sure everyone has their name on the back!)
